



Did you Know?...

- 1 in 4 children in Ohio live in poverty.
- 1 in 4 children in our community go to bed hungry.
- 1 in 4 children are alone and unsupervised during the hours after school.
- Only 15% of Ohio's K-12 children participate in after-school programs.
- 1 in 30 children in Ohio experience homelessness.

What is LemonAiD?

LemonAiD is a fun Salvation Army initiative where caring kids help impoverished kids in Central Ohio by holding a lemonade stand.

The Concept is simple—kids help other kids by holding a lemonade stand (with parent/guardian supervision) on their own time, within their own community! The Salvation Army provides an official LemonAiD sign, badges and stickers to get kids started. Funds raised are donated to The Salvation Army for its youth programming.

The Impact

- Kids participating learn a priceless lesson that they can make a positive difference in their community. LemonAiD provides a fun and meaningful family and youth community outreach project.
- The Salvation Army will use 100% of the proceeds to help poverty-stricken children by providing hot meals, after-school and summer education, recreation programs, mentoring by caring adults, music classes, scholarships to summer camp and more.

The Campaign runs during June and July, and culminates with an optional celebration for all participants in mid-July. Stands can also be held in May and August.
