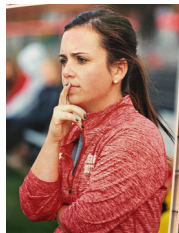


Mark Wise is the director of the camp. He has over 20 years coaching experience coaching youth and adult players. He is currently the head girls soccer coach at Westerville South.

Training

The focus of the youth camps at Westerville South is on individual skill development. Each session is designed to help the participant learn how to master the control of a soccer ball.

Each night will focus on a different aspect of ball control, juggling, trapping, passing/receiving, turning, finishing. At the end of each night the campers will be given the opportunity to try out these skills in a small sided scrimmage environment.

Camp Fees

The camp fee is \$75 for the week and includes 4 nights of 90 minutes of instruction and a camp t-shirt.

What to bring

Be properly dressed, wear soccer cleats and shin guards. Bring plenty of water and a soccer ball. Size 4 is best for players under 12, Size 5 for everyone else.
