

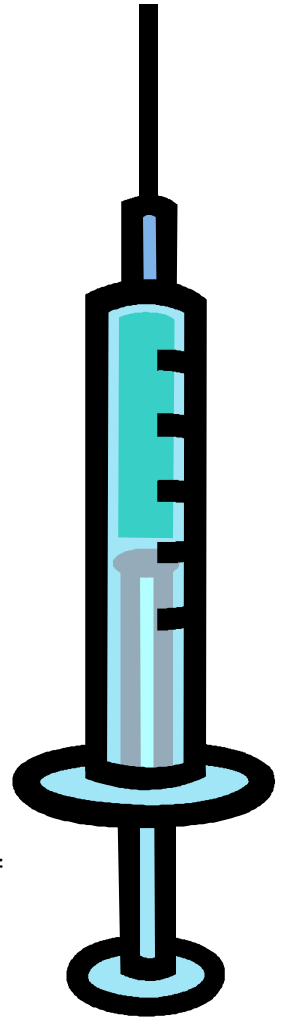
IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS

The **State of Ohio** requires children to be immunized if they are enrolled in public or private school for kindergarten,

Please Submit Shot Records at Registration

KINDERGARTNERS NEED:

1. **HBV or HepB** (Hepatitis B)
3 doses required – may take 6 months to complete
2. **MMR** (Measles, mumps, rubella)
2 doses required, the first dose given on or after the first birthday.
3. **DPT, DtaP or DT** (Diphtheria, pertussis, tetanus)
5 doses required, unless the 4th dose was administered on or after the fourth birthday.
4. **OPV or IPV** (polio)
3 or more doses required: last dose to be given on or after 4th B-day.
5. **VARIVAX** (chicken pox vaccine) or disease history
2 doses required, the 1st dose being given on or after the first birthday. If the student has had the disease, verification/date may be provided by physician or parent.

¹The Columbus Health Department charges a \$21.00 administration fee per injection plus a \$16.00 nurse assessment fee per visit.

²The Franklin County Board of Health charges a \$20.00 administrative fee for the first injection and \$15.00 for each additional injection.

³Delaware County Board of Health charges \$19.00 for the first injection and \$10.00 for each additional injection.
